Now I suppose that would be like a student union today, where people met. And my second year there I had to work in a home in Bloomington, take care of a little girl part of the time, and um, so I had to take my lunch so that's where we gals that did that sort of thing and came in from Bloomington on a bus, that's where we always ate our lunch, in that lounge downstairs.
